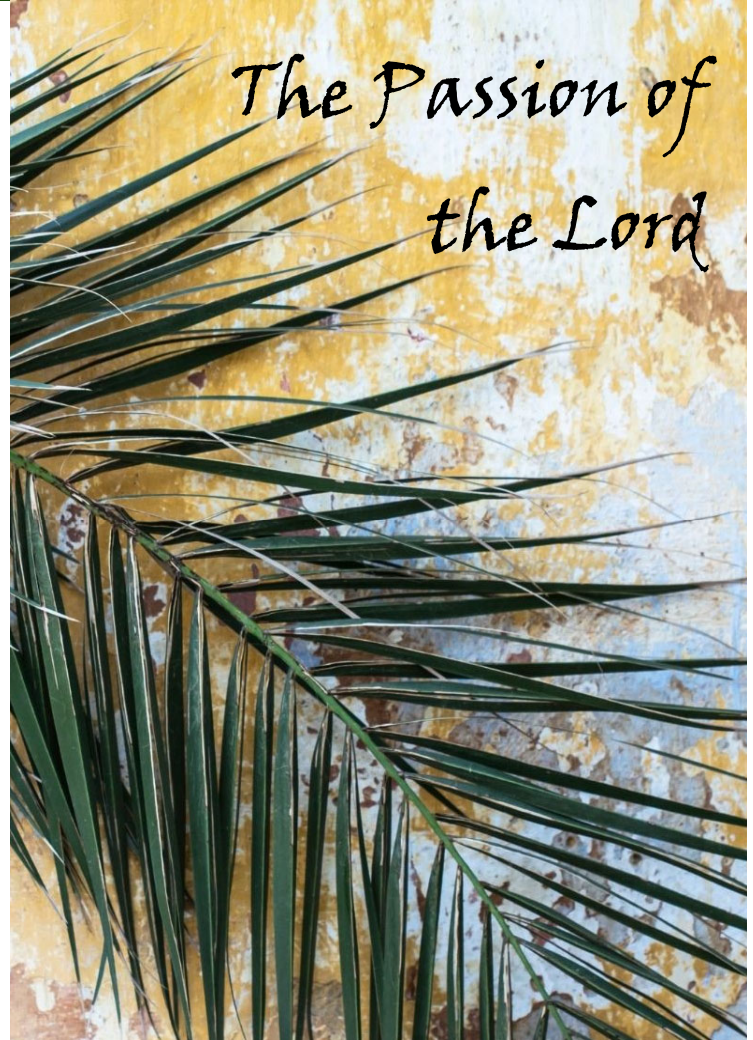

GOOD FRIDAY CROSS WALK

On April 7th starting at 4:30 PM, we will walk from St Augustine's Church through the streets of Pleasanton to St. Elizabeth Seton Church. 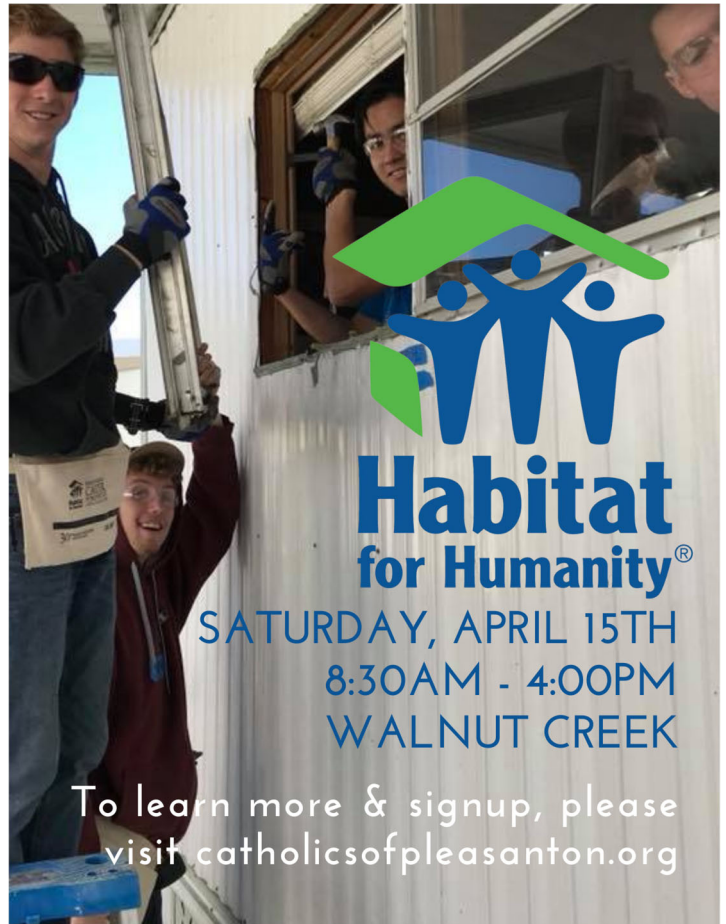
