

# Year 2 Sacrament Preparation

Attendance – regular Youth Group Attendance is expected. Please notify the Coordinator in advance if an absence is needed.

Mass – Mass attendance is an expectation for Catholic Christians. Our youth families typically attend our 4pm or 6pm Sunday Mass. Families will be required to attend at least FOUR of the following Masses:

All Saints Day

All Souls Day

Christmas

Ash Wednesday

Palm Sunday

Maundy (Holy Thursday)

Good Friday

Holy Saturday/Easter Vigil

Easter

Please bring the Mass' Worship Aid (with student name) to the next youth group.

Ministry – Families will be asked to sign-up for either 'Greeter' duties or 'Cookie' ministry.

Greeters arrive to Mass 15 minutes early and greet the community as they arrive and hand out Worship Aids. The Liturgical Coordinator has the Worship Aids on the tables in the vestibule and family members should be at each of the two doors greeting the community as they arrive.

Cookie ministry – Assist the Gather & Share Ministry with distributing goodies after Mass and then cleaning up. This event is in the planning stages, so more details and sign-up information will follow. Currently, the plan is to have this event on the fourth Sunday of each month.
