


Pentecost Sunday May 19, 2023

You take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer;


You are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

"Veni Sancte Spiritus" is one of only four medieval Sequences which were preserved in the Roman Missal published in 1570 following the Council of Trent (1545-63).


