_____ Childcare Volunteer: Time commitment variable. Volunteers are needed in the childcare room to assist other volunteers willing to teach but have younger children not yet enrolled in Faith Formation. Volunteers would be scheduled at the same time that their own child is attending Faith Formation class. With enough volunteers time commitment could be anywhere from once a month to 3 or 4 times during the year.

_____ Catechist: Time commitment would be 2 to 3 hours per week for lesson preparation and the teaching of class. In addition to the actual preparation and teaching time, a commitment must be made to one's own formation. Formation will include catechist formation sessions, grade level meetings and other workshops that are available with the goal of becoming a certified catechist.

_____ Middle School Volunteer:

_____ AMP it UP! Advisory Council

Meet once monthly to plan/coordinate various events such as social service, liturgy involvement, and social events.

_____ Retreat Team

Plan retreat, co-facilitate small group and large group activities for the 8th grade retreats

_____ Retreat/Event Help

Chaperones, activity leaders, musicians, and/or cooks are needed for both retreats

_____ Hospitality Team

Coordinate hospitality for projects, guest speaker events, and graduation reception

_____ All Hallows Eve Party

Coordinators to plan, set up, and break down the All Hallows Eve party

_____ Social Justice Team

Coordinators to plan and implement social justice opportunities for our AMP program

_____ High School Youth Ministries and Confirmation Volunteer:

_____ Core Team (plans and initiates our Sunday night Youth Group, Overtime).

_____ Confirmation Year One Team (Facilitates a small group for one academic year till the time the kids celebrate Confirmation, usually in May. Groups meet twice a month).

_____ Confirmation Year Two Team (Adults will assist Catholicism 101 & 102 Workshop Coordinators. C101 takes place in the Fall, C102 takes place in the Spring).

_____ Retreat Teams (Several retreats take place throughout the year: LinC, Acts, Confirmation).

_____ Retreat Cooking Crew (Twice a year we provide our own food crew on retreat).

_____ Event Help (Chaperones are needed for various events throughout the year and summer).

_____ Youth Liturgy Committee (Helps plan the 6:30 PM Mass at St. Elizabeth Seaton).

_____ Youth Advisory Board (evaluate program components as set forth by the Youth Minister)

_____ Youth Liturgy Gospel Drama Coordinator (Helps prepare students for various liturgical dramas and other movement).

_____ SOS (Service on Sunday will occur once a month. This program feeds the homeless. Adults are needed to help)
