Elementary Program

_____ Childcare Volunteer: Provide childcare for the preschool aged children of catechists. Volunteers would be scheduled at the same time that their own child is attending Faith Formation class. Tim commitment varies depending on how many parents offer to help with childcare. Childcare volunteers will provide babysitting Monday-Thursday afternoons.

_____ Childcare Coordinator: Make a schedule for childcare volunteers who will be in the nursery Monday – Thursday afternoons. Call volunteers before their scheduled day to remind them of “nursery duty”.

_____ Catechist: Time commitment would be 2 to 3 hours per week for lesson preparation and the teaching of class. In addition to the actual preparation and teaching time, a commitment must be made to one’s own formation. Formation will include catechist formation sessions, grade level meetings and other workshops that are available with the goal of becoming a certified catechist.
