

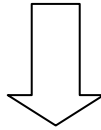

Registration Instructions

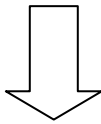
We hope that the following steps will help the registration process flow smoothly for you.

STEP 1: Are you registered in the Parish? If the answer is YES, skip to STEP 2! If the answer is NO, please fill out the Parish Registration form on our webpage and return it with the other registration materials.



STEP 2a: Fill out both pages of the Faith Formation Registration Form and The Family Information Form. If you have questions about the program you are registering for, or whether your child is eligible to celebrate a sacrament this year (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation and Reconciliation), please refer to the Program Information. Don't forget to sign the Health Authorization Form!

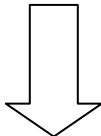
STEP 2b: Fill out the volunteer sign-up sheet. Each family must sign up for at least one volunteer opportunity.



STEP 3: Mail or walk in the paperwork, no earlier than May 18th. Make sure you have included the following:

- Faith Formation Registration Form, both pages.
- Parish Registration Form, if needed,
- Baptismal certificates for each child being enrolled if needed. If you have supplied us with a certificate for that child in previous years OR if your child has been baptized here in the parish, this does NOT apply to you.
- Payment of \$130.00 per family. If your child is celebrating a sacrament (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation and Reconciliation) there is an additional materials fee of \$40.00. Please make checks out to CCOP (Catholic Community of Pleasanton).

Forms received before May 18th will be processed after all others received on the 18th.



STEP 4: You will receive a letter advising you of your time slot for the Sunday, August 23rd Placement Day (Elementary Program only) or the date and time of the organizational meeting for all other programs (Preschool, Middle School, High School, Confirmation, Family Program, Intergenerational Family Communities (IFCs), Christian Initiation of Children (CIC)).
