



The love of Christ joins us together. Let us rejoice in him, and in our love and care for all now love God in return.


In true communion let us gather. May all divisions cease and in their place be Christ the Lord, our risen Prince of Peace.

For the Lord is your rock, your fortress, your stronghold. It is he who saves you, protects you from death.


In your lives you shall know how good is the Lord, His kindness, his love without end.



Lift your hearts! Lift your hearts! He is alive!


Here now is mercy embracing your soul;

here the fulfillment that once was foretold.


It is true! It is true! He is alive!




