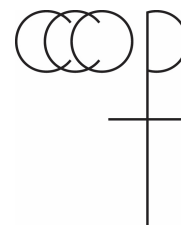

Pastor's Corner

My brothers and sisters,

Let's look ahead to next weekend when the Gospel narrates how Jesus performs the miracle of feeding thousands of people with just a few fish and loaves of bread. Jesus recognizes that you must feed both the spirit and the body, satisfying the most basic of human needs. He does this by calling on the most ordinary of people, like you and me, to give what they have. First a small boy offers up his meal of fish and bread. Then the disciples use their gifts to

distribute the food so that everyone in the crowd is fed. If we follow their example and give a little of what we have with an open heart and mind, we can also accomplish the enormous task of feeding many in our world today.

We have an opportunity to do some "hands on" giving and support **Kids Against Hunger**. This is a global solidarity initiative sponsored by the Catholic Community of Pleasanton's Social Justice Committee. Let us give a little of our time, just two hours, to help pack meals for
