

The following are the requirements of year two of the Confirmation program:

Expectations:

1. A clear understanding that all requirements are mandatory and must be completed by the candidate and supported by family.
2. An authentic willingness to participate and strengthen your faith.

Requirements:

- Code of Conduct signed by Teen and at least one parent/guardian
- Year 2 Covenant signed by Teen and at least one parent/guardian
- Full, conscious and active participation at home, school, youth ministry & Confirmation prep: Example: fulfilling responsibilities (chores, homework, attending classes, etc.)
- Attend all classes
- Attend 2 Youth Ministry Social Events or youth group. Socials are held throughout the year and youth group is Monday nights.
- Participation in 6:30 Mass a minimum of 4 times (these do not count for service hours), as COVID allows
- The Year 2 Confirmation Retreat— January 29-January 31 as COVID allows
- Attend Mass regularly, and special liturgies: Rites and Youth Masses.
- Attend a minimum of two Reconciliations – One each during Advent and Lent
- The selection of a Sponsor who will attend occasional meetings, due by October 2020
- Attend a minimum of one of the Triduum services at CCOP
- The selection of a Confirmation Name and saint assignment
- Statement of Faith/Personal Creed
- Proof of your Baptism (even if baptized at CCOP) ASAP
- Service in the parish through various ministry opportunities or outside Non-profit charity-based organization (20 Hours)- 10 hours must be done at CCOP, the additional 10 may be done at an outside organization. You must have at least 2 different service organizations. Due by May 1st, 2021
- At least 2 hours of service or a social must be completed with your sponsor.
- Attend the Sponsor Retreat
- Attend Stations of the Cross (Date TBA) with sponsor or parent.
- Fill out the Sacrament Information Form – FEBRUARY 2021
- Attend Confirmation Rehearsal – TBA
- Attend Confirmation Mass – TBA

At any time should your teen, or a member of your family choose to break this Covenant, or Code of Conduct you may be asked to leave the program.

If, after reviewing the requirements, you see any potential conflicts, it is your (the candidate, supported by parent,) responsibility to express the concerns to the youth minister immediately (before the event takes place). Issues will be addressed on a case by case basis.
