PART ONE—SETTING UP A SPACE

Due to COVID restrictions, some of your Confirmation preparation will be done independently at home. This will be an important part of your faith journey. You want to be in the right environment to take the time to properly reflect on what you will be learning. Look around your home and find a few spots that you know you can be comfortable in, and make sure it has internet access so you can visit the website for assignments, and watch videos as needed. Additional items you might want to include are any religious symbols (a cross, a bible, saint cards, etc.) If you would like a Saint card, or even a vinyl sticker for your water bottle, reach out to me (Lien-Thi) and let me know! PART TWO—SIGN UP FOR FORMED.ORG & WATCH A VIDEO

This is free for you! Make sure you can access Formed. It's available on Roku, Apple TV, your phone (iPhone and Android) and your computer! Instructions on how to sign up for FORMED.ORG are to the right.

After you have signed up for Formed, watch any two videos from the "Catholic Answers: Ready Reasons." Pick any two that look interesting to you, or that you want to learn more about. Each video is 2-3 minutes long. Remember the names or subjects of the videos you picked to watch, you'll have to write them down on an assignment.

PART THREE—VISIT THE WEBSITE

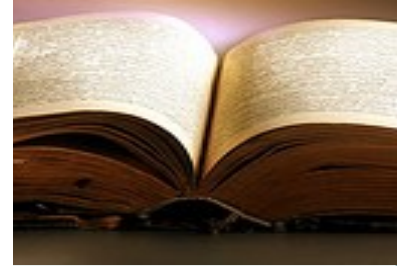
